Becoming a Regional Ambassador

Calling all **community organizers, network builders, and socially minded changemakers** with a gift for facilitating human connection, inclusion, and collaboration. Volunteer to be a RSA US regional ambassador to build out a hub for the RSA in your local area.

ROLE DESCRIPTION



- **Build connection** — act as the main point of contact for Fellows in your area who are interested in place-based activities
- **Curate and organize events** — plan events focused on place-based learning, action, connection and engagement opportunities that feature key actors in your local area
- **Facilitate events** — ensure that all events are warm and welcoming spaces for everyone who chooses to attend
- **Grow the network** — spark connections between Fellows in your area and recommend the Fellowship to movers you come into contact with
- **Collaborate with others** — attend quarterly Ambassador check in calls and occasional office hours with RSA US staff
- **Experiment and share** — be open to testing out new ideas and sharing learning

QUALIFICATIONS



- **You're a change-maker.** You are aligned with the RSA's values and you're enthusiastic about the RSA's role in accelerating social change.
- **You believe in the power of community.** It's in your DNA. You enjoy bringing people together to discuss key issues affecting your area.
- **You have an eye for detail.** You know what makes a successful event and have some experience in community organizing or event management.
- **You enjoy collaborating with others but also work semi-autonomously.** You thrive in diverse environments and enjoy working with others. You're also able to work on your own initiative and access relevant support tools.
- **You're inclusive.** You foster a warm and welcoming space for everyone to come together regardless of race, gender and gender identity, sexual orientation, age, disability, physical appearance or religion.
- **You're an active and connected disseminator of ideas.** You believe in sparking connections, sharing ideas, experimenting and testing.

TIME COMMITMENT

- Ambassadors commit to serving one 18-month term. This term can be extended or renewed by mutual agreement.
- The average ambassador dedicates around 4-6 hours a month to their role
