**Q2. Different arrangements are in place or have been proposed to make elected Mayors accountable. For instance, in the capital, a body of 25 elected politicians (the London Assembly) scrutinises the work of the Mayor, who has powers over key policy areas like transport and crime. In Greater Manchester, the elected Mayor can take decisions only with the support of local councils. Others have proposed that randomly-selected 'citizen juries' or assemblies could scrutinise the output of Mayors, operating like jurists on a trial.
